Dear Harkham GAON Families,

Yesterday afternoon, our high school girls were privileged to be invited to an inspirational event called "Tikva," with other high school girls from throughout the greater Los Angeles area that was held here at Beth Jacob. As I walked through the halls and peeked into some of the activities, it was heartening to hear conversations among the girls demonstrating an awareness of our school. I am hoping that our continued efforts to work together with you - our families - and our community will result in enrolling more students, and especially more girls, at our school.
